The new modern garden centers have been built with special focus on the environment, where, among other things, solar cells have been installed on the roof, which covers 50-60% of the electricity consumption. In addition, rainwater is also collected for watering the plants.

At the same time, and similar to the rest of the chain's centers, electronic price tags have been installed throughout the store, saving huge amounts of paper on daily basis.
